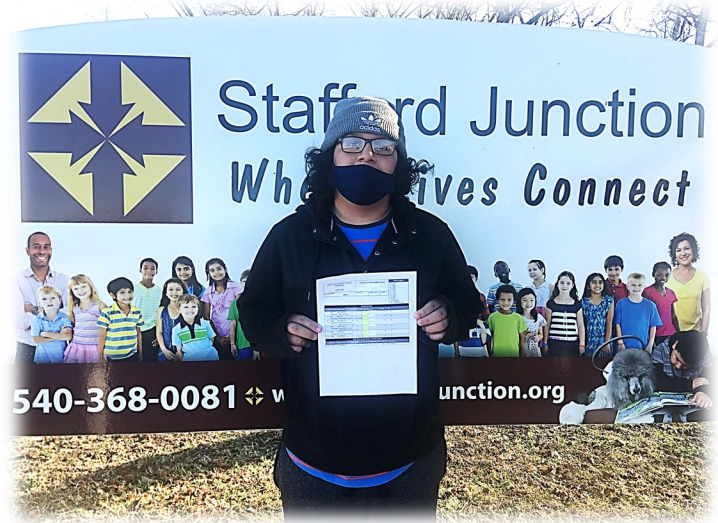
LEARNING LAB
