SUMMER JUNCTION

Stafford Junction is gearing up for our Summer Junction program, this program is designed to help combat summer learning loss while having fun. The camp focuses on maintaining math and reading levels while engaging in fun activities. We offer a nutritious lunch, math and reading classes, STEAM classes, sports, self-directed play, cooking classes, arts & crafts, field trips, and Tide Me Over (TMO) bags to take home. Summer Junction also provides a chance for meaningful youth-adult relationships to restore trust in youth who are at-risk.

Summer programs have proven to have a positive influence on children's cognitive, behavioral, physical, social, and emotional development. Summer Junction provides low-income children with meaningful experiences, skills, and achievements that they would normally not have access to. Your donations help provide this opportunity to our participants at no cost to them. Summer Junction begins with a week of Stafford County Sheriff's Office Baseball Camp, followed by 4 weeks of Camp NorthStar at Stafford Junction, and ends with a week of soccer camp.
